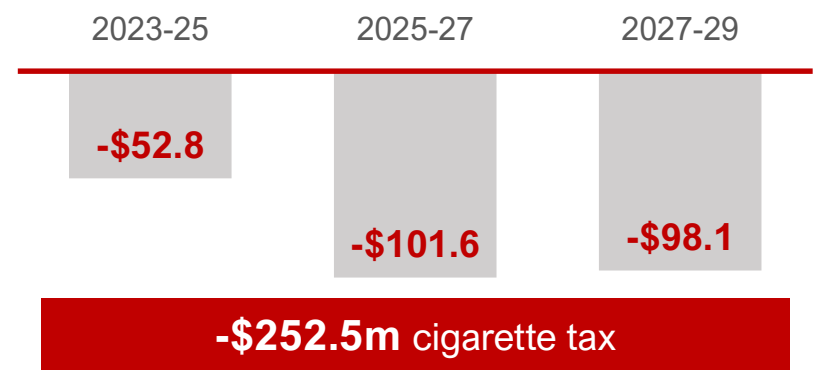
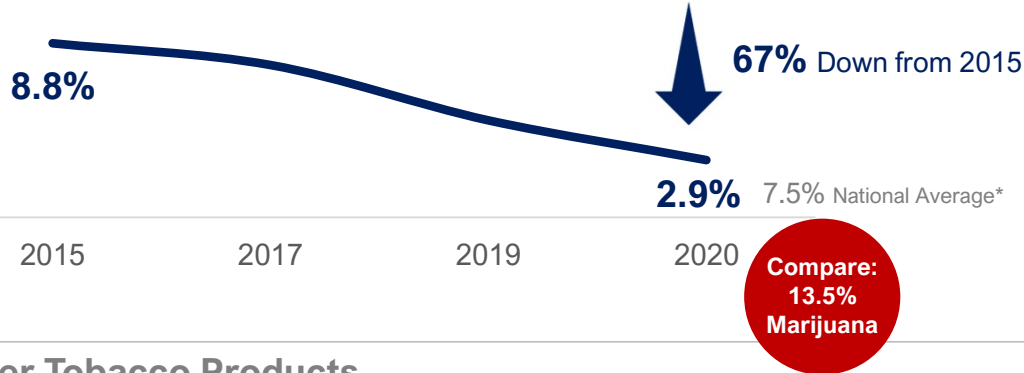

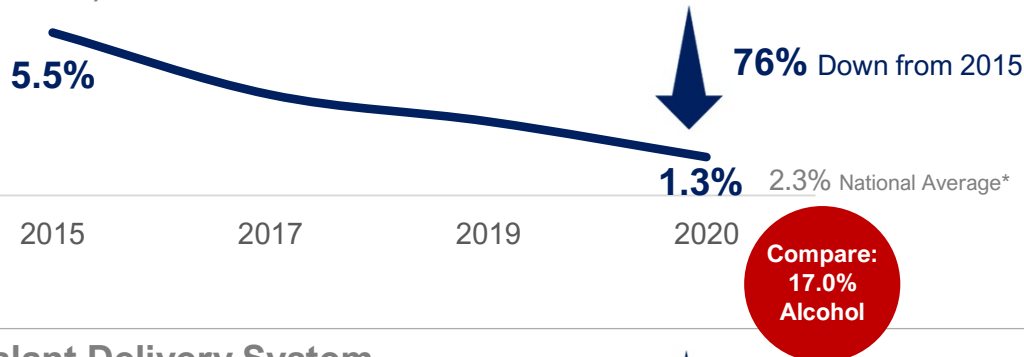
Oregon Student Health Survey: Tobacco Youth Use¹

(Biennium in \$Millions)

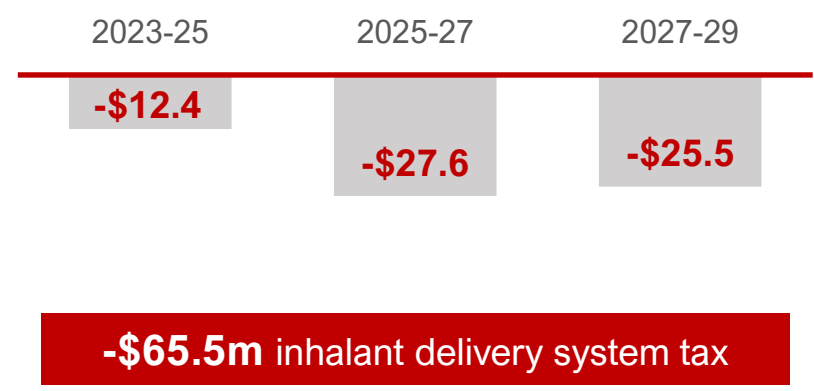
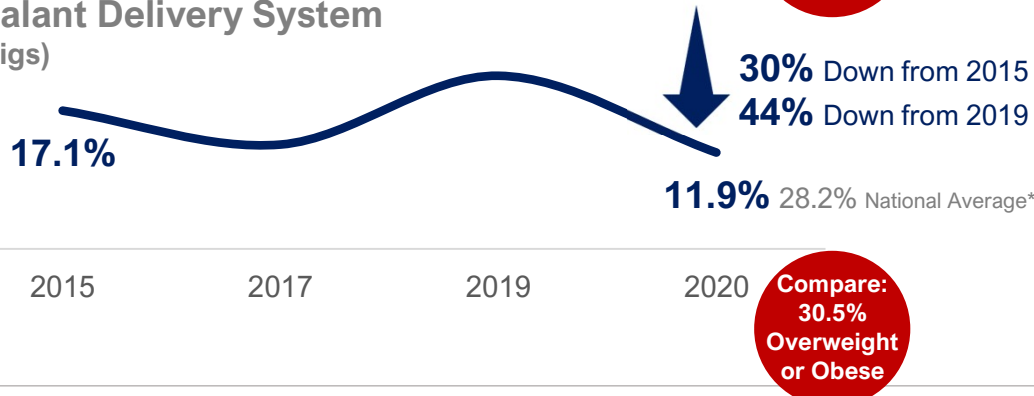
